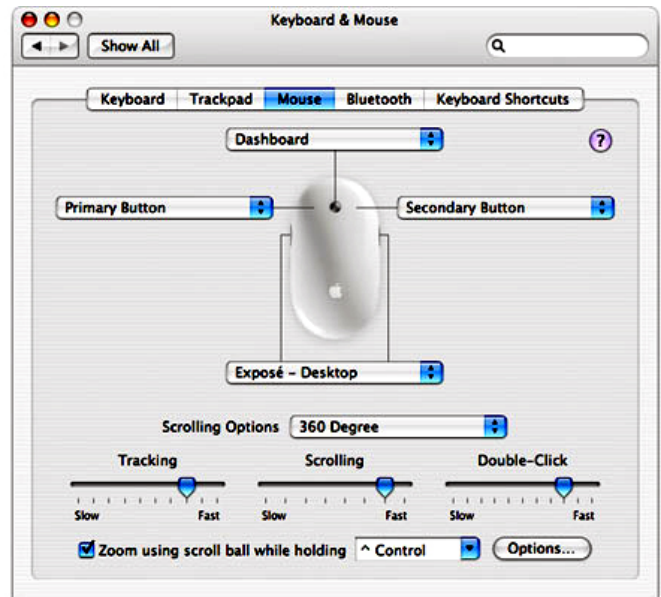


There are several options for right clicking on an Apple computer:

1. Hold down the control key (CNTRL) and click the mouse button.
2. Purchase a Multi-button USB mouse.

They are very inexpensive. To configure the right mouse button, select System Preferences from the Apple menu, and then select Keyboard & Mouse. Select the Mouse tab. Use the setting displayed:



3. If you are using the laptop track pad, you can set the lower right corner of the track pad to be the right click – **One Finger; Secondary Click**. See image below – select **Trackpad** in **System Preferences...**
